AGB – GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Conditions of Participation:

1.1. The organizer of the Linz Danube Marathon is the Linzer Veranstaltungsgesellschaft m.b.H., Untere Donaulände 7, 4010 Linz (Tel: +43(0)732/7612-0 or +43(0)732/603412, DVR-Nr. 0047261, Email: linzmarathon@liva.linz.at).

1.2. These terms and conditions of participation apply to all participants who take part in one of the competitions held as part of the Linz Danube Marathon. The organizer reserves the right to change the content of these terms and conditions of participation at any time and to adapt them to the current state.

1.3. Anyone who has reached the age specified in the tender for the respective route is entitled to participate in the Linz Danube Marathon. The prerequisite for participation is the proper registration for the registration modalities described in more detail on the website www.linzmarathon.at. In the case of young participants, a registration is only effective if it is also effectively signed by the legal representative.

1.4. Participation in the event is a highly personal right and cannot be transferred to third parties. The start numbers are not transferable.

1.5. In the case of rebooking, e.g. when downgrading to another competition (change of discipline) e.g. marathon to half marathon, the entry fee already paid will not be refunded, not even on a pro-rata basis. In the case of an upgrade, e.g. half marathon to marathon, a renewed payment of the entry fee for the new competition is not necessary, but the difference to the entry fee for the more expensive competition plus any bank charges on top of the entry fee valid at the time of re-registration must be paid by the participants. In the event of inability to participate, race entries can be transferred to the event of the following year once with a transfer fee of €25.00. The transfer can be made to the same competition the following year. Upgrades or downgrades are treated as in section 1.5. In the case of a transfer to the next year, participants must contact the organizers in writing by email to linzmarathon@liva.linz.at up to 7 days before the event, providing personal data as well as event-related information. Transfer of unused race entries after the event has concluded is not possible.

Re-registration: It is possible to swap participants and/or change classifications. Up to one week after the last entry deadline, re-registration can be carried out free of charge (except for collective collection and school runs), only the difference will be charged for an upgrade. After that, changes of any kind can be made at the sports fair. An additional processing fee of €10 will be charged for this.

The current entry fees for individual competitions can be found at www.linzmarathon.at.

1.6. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants and to no longer accept registrations that exceed this limit.

2. Disclaimer:

2.1. Participation is at the participants' own risk. By receiving the race numbers, participants declare that they have no health concerns regarding participation. It is the participants' responsibility to have their health checked by a medical professional beforehand. The organizer assumes no liability for the health risks of the participants.

2.2. Liability of the organizer, its representatives, and agents for personal, material, and financial damages is excluded – as far as legally permissible. The organizer is not liable for negligently caused material and financial damages.

2.3. The organizer assumes no liability for items of the participants stored during the running event by third parties commissioned by the organizer. Any liability of the organizer due to gross negligence remains unaffected.

2.4. The organizer is entitled to modify the event, or to partially or completely cancel it, in cases of force majeure, for the safety of the participants, or for other important reasons. In these cases - as far as legally permissible - there is no right to refund the entry fee and no obligation of the organizer to compensate the participants.

2.5. Cases of force majeure include all measures related to or arising from the COVID-19 pandemic or a comparable spreading epidemic. The organizer is – particularly in 2026 and beyond – entitled to modify the course of the event or parts of it, to relocate or shorten routes, to completely or temporarily cancel the competitions, to limit them in part, to close them or to cancel them in full. The organizer is entitled to take such measures, in particular, if the planned implementation or continuation of the event could endanger the participants, visitors or the general public, if an official event ban would be ordered for the competition (s) or if the event could no longer be carried out in an economically viable manner due to restrictions imposed by law or by the authorities. The participants have to accept and follow any official requirements or orders that are prescribed to the organizer. The participants will be notified in advance of such conditions and / or changes by email or on the website for the respective competition. The participants are requested to keep themselves informed, at least on the day of the event.

2.6. In the event of an official cancellation of the Linz Danube Marathon, the organizer reserves the possibility to hold all events of the Linz Danube Marathon as a Virtual Run. Registered participants will be transferred to the Virtual Run and will receive the race number including a starter package, provided that the registered participant does not receive a written objection to the transfer to the Virtual Run from the organizer within three days of the official rejection being announced and published on our website. With the transfer to the Virtual Run, the registered participants are not entitled to reimbursement of the entry fees.

A refund of the entry fee is only possible in the event of a complete cancellation of the event, if the cancellation is attributable to the organizer without a valid reason as per points 2.4 and 2.5. If the cancellation is attributable to the organizer, a partial refund of the entry fees paid by the participants will be made after deducting the proportionate expenses already incurred by the organizer. Participants are responsible for demonstrating that the share of expenses already incurred by the organizer would have actually been lower.

2.7. If duly registered participants do not participate in the event for whatever reason or declare their non-participation to the organizer before the event, they have no claim to a refund of the entry fee.

3. Safety Measures:

3.1. Participation in the event using sports equipment such as racing wheelchairs (excluding handbike races), bicycles, and inline skates (excluding inline skating competitions), or Nordic walking sticks/cross-country skiing sticks and Smovey rings is not permitted. Accompanying participants who are not registered for the running competitions (especially on bicycles, strollers, roller skates, or other sports equipment or vehicles) are prohibited and automatically lead to the disqualification of the participants.

3.2. Participation without a start number or without the chip provided for timing will also result in immediate disqualification.

3.3. The organizer reserves the right to reject registrations for important reasons, exclude participants from the start, or disqualify them. Disqualification occurs, in particular, if the allocated race number is passed on to third parties, is changed in any way, especially if the advertising print is made invisible, illegible, or changed in any way. Other reasons for exclusion exist in particular if the participants provide false information about themselves, a ban has been imposed by one of the responsible sports associations, there is a suspicion of taking unauthorized substances or the behavior of the participants disrupt the course of the event or the safety of the endanger other participants. Disqualified participants will not be allowed to start in the following 2 years. Disqualification can also be performed by the race director during the race if the race is endangered, particularly by disregarding instructions.

3.4. In the case of exclusion of participants for the reasons mentioned in this section, there is no right to a refund of the entry fee.

4. Data Collection and Use of Images:

4.1. The personal data provided when registering are organized by the Linz Danube Marathon by the Linzer Veranstaltungsgesellschaft mbH stored and processed for the purpose of carrying out and handling the event, including the purpose of medical care and care for the participants during and in connection with the event, timekeeping and for media reporting purposes.

The participants are informed that the photos, film recordings and interviews taken in connection with participation in the event may be distributed, published or used in all media and on all data carriers without any claim to remuneration. The organizer selects the published images with due care so that there is no negative representation of the participants.

4.4. The data protection provisions are available for your information when you register online and can be downloaded from the www.linzmarathon.at website

4.5. Participants declare that they consent to the event-related information from the organizer in electronic form and/or by post.

5. Timing

5.1. The time measurement for the event is carried out by a third party commissioned by the organizer, currently mika: timing GmbH.

5.2. The participants undertake to carry the technical measurement required for timing during the race on the start number (as received when the start documents were issued). The technical measurement must not be broken. A time measurement can only take place if the chip is used properly and if the route laid down by the organizer is adhered to. If intermediate times are missing or measured intermediate times appear implausible, the organizer reserves the right to disqualify these participants.

6. Miscellaneous

6.1. The event takes place in all weathers. However, the organizer reserves the right to either cancel the event before it begins or to break it off prematurely during the event if the health of the participants could be endangered due to weather conditions or for other reasons.

6.2. Typesetting and printing errors are reserved.

6.3. For all disputes arising from or in connection with the registration and / or participation in the event, Austrian law is exclusively applicable. The place of jurisdiction is the competent court in Linz.
